Warsaw Community Schools Construction Project Groundbreaking Ceremony Set for December 17th

Warsaw, IN. Warsaw Community Schools will host a groundbreaking ceremony at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday at the current Lincoln Elementary site to signal the start of construction of a renovation project approved by voters in May 2015. The project includes major renovations and additions to Washington Elementary School and Edgewood Middle School and building an entirely new Lincoln Elementary School. The design-build technical review committee for the project chose the Performance Services design-build team at a meeting held Friday, October 16, 2015. Design partners include Kovert Hawkins Architects, Veridus Group, Lynch, Harrison and Brumleve, Primary Engineering, and Technology Dynamics.
